Volleyball – Individual Skills and Team (Traditional and Unified)

Volleyball Opening Ceremonies will be at 8:30 AM.

Registration Guidelines

- Athletes may enter in one event.
- A 9 game **average** must be submitted as an entry score for all bowlers (including Unified Sports® partners)
- For Doubles and Teams, please enter the 9 game average from EACH person on the team.
- Unified Sports® teams ideally shall consist of two Special Olympics athletes and two non-disabled peers.
Teams will be able to list one athlete alternate and for Unified one partner that will have to have bowled at the Regional competition. The 9 game average should be similar to those in the team.
- Competition attire includes:
 - Bowling shoes (**required**)
 - Casual sports shirt/polo
 - Casual slacks/skirt or pants/shorts/jeans are allowed.
- Everyone must participate in the regional competition in the same event they will compete in at state.

Registration Guidelines

- If athletes are interested in Skills Competition, please contact the Director of Competition.
- Athletes may enter one event.
- Each Unified Sports® team shall have a *non-playing coach* responsible for the line-up and conduct of the team during competition.
- Teams must include a team name with their registration.
- Team rosters may have a minimum of six players and a maximum of **twelve players**.
- The age of the oldest team member will determine the teams grouping for both Special Olympics and Unified Sports® divisions. Please note the new rule for 2018 – all athletes on adult teams must be 16 years old or older.
- The preferred line-up for Unified Sports® teams shall consist of three athletes and three partners. Failure to have 3 or more athletes on the floor at any time will result in a forfeit.
- Competition attire includes:
 - Jersey or T-shirt (long sleeved desired)
 - Numbers on front and back of jersey (**required**)
 - Shorts or sweatpants (no jeans)
 - Court shoes and socks
- All Individual competitors, Individual Skills competitors, Special Olympics teams and Unified Sports® teams must participate in a Regional event to be eligible for advancement to the State tournament. Rosters must remain the same from Regional Competition to State Competition.
