In order to provide a fair and competitive bowling competition, Special Olympics Colorado will be enforcing the following rules as set by Special Olympics Inc. and the World Tenpin Bowling Association.

1. Foul lights will be in use. This means when a player crosses the foul line, it counts as a ball bowled, but the player is not credited with any pins that were knocked down by that ball.
2. All players will be alternating lanes per frame. This rule does not apply to Ramp bowlers.
3. All Bowlers will bowl 3 games. Ramp bowlers (assisted and unassisted) will bowl 2 games.
4. All bowlers need to be at the bowling center on time – a player or team missing one or more frames by not being present and ready to bowl in turn shall:
 - a. Be able to be blinded for the first 3 frames of that game. If they arrive during that time will start play on that frame. If not, they will have to wait until the next game.
 - b. They are not able to make up the missing frames (score will be zero for those frames).
5. No changes to your teams' lineup will be permitted unless you will be using alternates listed on your entries. If your team is missing a member, the team can bowl, but will have to use a zero for the score of the missing bowler. The team will be awarded in your division based on this score.
6. This is a scratch tournament. No handicaps will be used. All divisoning was done based on the scores from your regional competition.
7. Seating is limited, please be respectful of other spectators.
8. No coaches or parents are allowed on the lanes at any time. Only individuals with pre-approved credentials will be permitted on the lanes. Please share this information with parents and spectators.
